Review the scenario below, complete the tasks as outlined and answer all questions. If a task does not have a specific question, initial it to indicate completion. Once all tasks are complete, present your answers to the Trainer. You will receive the next scenario.

Scenario

The date is May 30, 2014. Your patient arrives at the Emergency Department presenting with a fever and worsening cough. He reports taking insulin for his diabetes. As part of the assessment, routine blood work is drawn. Abnormal values are present.

Your patient states he has had recent bloodwork drawn elsewhere. You want to know if the abnormal values are a recent change. You access the ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer to look for more information.

Task	Question	Answer/Initials
1. Search for your patient using the Health Card Number.		
2. Change the timeline to be January 1, 2013 to today's date.		
3. To see detailed lab results, open up the Lab and Pathology Results portlet using the navigation bar.		
4. Go to the All tab and sort the "ordered as" column alphabetically to find CBC results.		
5. Filter by leukocytes.		
6. Open the OLIS full report dated May 15, 2014.	What was the leukocyte cell count?	
7. You want to see what other abnormal results exist. Sort the "All Labs" tab by abnormal lab results.	How is an abnormal result indicated?	
8. You want to trend of the HbA1c results in a flowsheet. Go to the flowsheet view.		
9. Change the chronological order in the flowsheet display.	What is the most recent fasting glucose available?	
10. Exit the flowsheet by going to the "All" tab. Customize the Lab and Pathology Results portlet to display the "Result" and "Test" columns on the far left. Add the "Source" column to the far right.		
11. Change the view back to the system default.
