

	ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer – Dispensed Medications	Drug Profile Viewer (DPV)
<b>What is it?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer is integrated with the provincial Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR)</li> <li>The Dispensed Medications tab in the Medications Portlet displays drug and pharmacy service information from the DHDR</li> </ul> <p>Authorized health care providers (HCPs) with access to the ClinicalViewer can access DHDR information in the Dispensed Medications tab</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DPV is a secure web-enabled application accessed through eHealth Portal (<a href="http://www.ehealthontario.ca">www.ehealthontario.ca</a>) using a ONEID credential</li> <li>Authorized health care providers (HCPs) in hospitals and some Community Health Centres can access DPV through the eHealth Portal</li> </ul>
<b>What data is available?</b>	<p>DHDR contains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Publicly funded drugs and pharmacy services (including monitored drugs) paid for by the ODB program. The ODB program includes the Trillium Drug Program (TDP) and OHIP+</li> <li>Most publicly funded drugs paid for by other public drug programs (e.g. Special Drugs Program - SDP)</li> <li>Monitored drugs (narcotics and controlled substances), regardless of payor, when the approved identification used was a valid Ontario Health Number. This includes monitored drugs reimbursed by private insurance or cash, which is information that's not available in DPV</li> </ul> <p>DHDR also includes additional clinically relevant data elements that are not currently viewable in DPV such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DIN/PIN</li> <li>Medical condition / reason for use (for some medications)</li> <li>Pharmacist name (for some medications)</li> <li>Current prescription number</li> <li>Historical Drug Utilization Review (DUR) information for some medications</li> </ul> <p>*Refer to <a href="#">Information Available to Health Care Providers through the Digital Health Drug Repository</a> for full details</p>	<p>DPV contains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Publicly funded drugs and pharmacy services (including monitored drugs) paid for by the ODB program. The ODB program includes the Trillium Drug Program (TDP)</li> <li>Most publicly funded drugs paid for by other public drug programs (e.g. Special Drugs Program - SDP)</li> </ul>
<b>How much data is available?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As of May 2017, includes approximately 7 years of publicly funded drugs and pharmacy services (including monitored drugs)</li> <li>As of May 2017, includes approximately 5 years of monitored drugs (narcotics and controlled substances), regardless of payor, when the approved identification used was a valid Ontario Health Number</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Includes up to 365 days of publicly funded drugs and pharmacy services (including monitored drugs)</li> </ul>
