

OLIS Connectivity Testing Instructions

Microsoft Windows

If using Microsoft Windows, and if the signing certificate with SSL Client Cert Type is installed in the Microsoft certificate "Current User" store, then you can test connectivity to the **OLIS CST environment** using Internet Explorer by entering the following URL:

<https://cst.olis.ssha.ca/ssha.olis.webservices.ER7/OLIS.asmx>

To test connectivity to the **OLIS production environment**, enter the following URL:

<https://olis.ssha.ca/ssha.olis.webservices.ER7/OLIS.asmx>

For the user who **comes from the Internet** the following host entry is required for **OLIS production** connectivity testing:

76.75.164.17 olis.ssha.ca

Internet Explorer may prompt you for which certificate to use to establish the connection. If successful, the following details should appear:

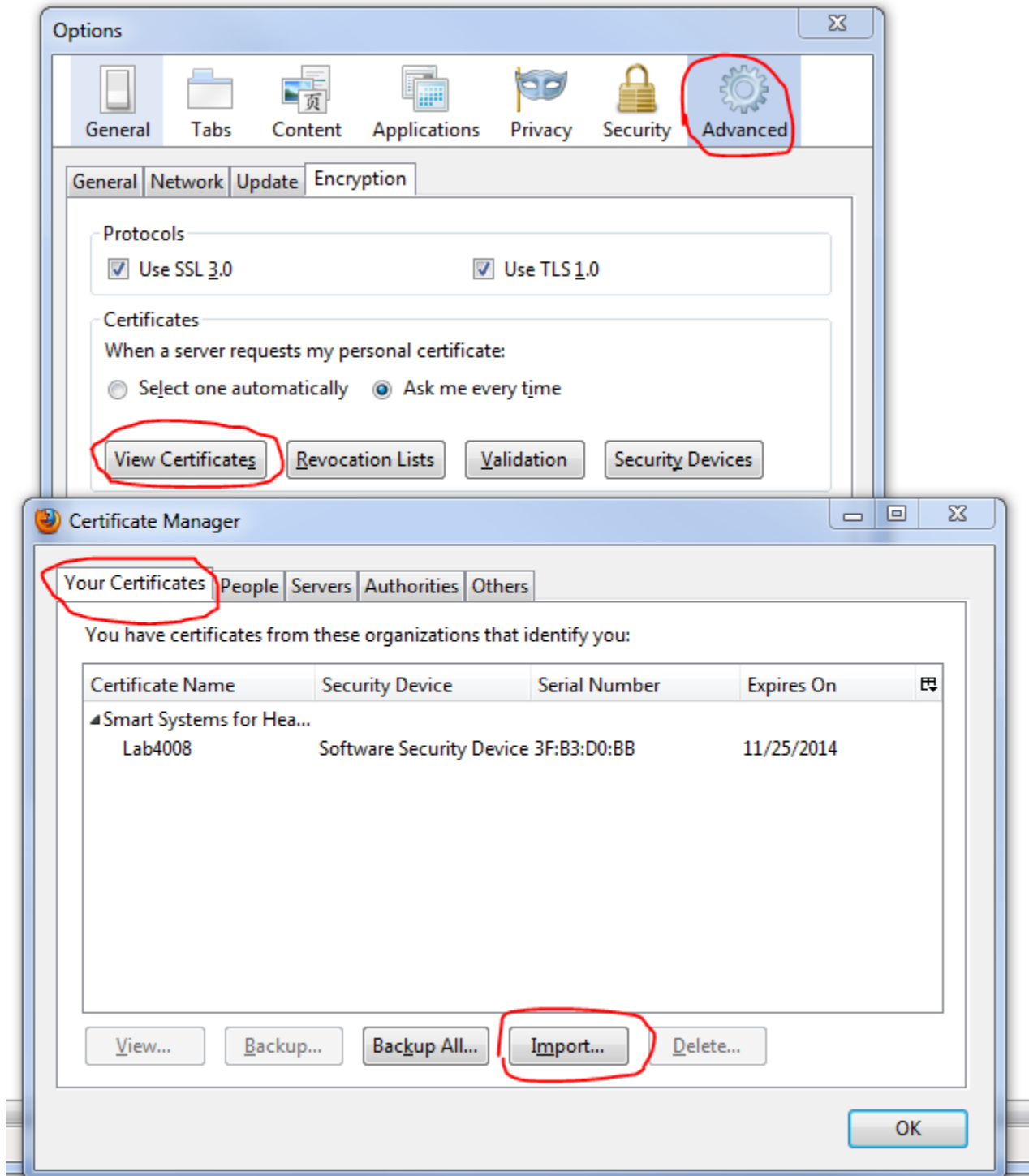
Firefox

If using **Firefox**, please export the certificate with the private key carried and import to Firefox certificate store via:

Tools -> Options -> Advanced -> View Certificate -> Your Certificate -> Import.

Also import the root certificate into Firefox certificate store via:

Tools -> Options -> Advanced -> View Certificate -> Authorities -> Import:
