

Both COVID-19 test results and vaccination information are available in ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer to authorized healthcare providers and organizations. For this information to display in the ClinicalViewer, the following conditions must be met:




- patient must have a valid Ontario Health Card Number
- patient must not have blocked the display of their medications, lab results or COVID-19 information
- required data repository must be available
- COVID-19 testing facility must contribute results to Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS)

If any of these conditions are not met, COVID-19 information will not display in the ClinicalViewer. [This does not necessarily mean that the patient has not been tested or vaccinated.](#)


COVID-19 information displays in two portlets as explained below.


COVID-19 Test Results Display in the Lab and Pathology Results Portlet

To view COVID-19 test results:

1. Adjust the timeline as required
2. In the Lab and Pathology Results portlet, select **Expand** 
OR
On the Navigation bar, select **Lab/Pathology Results** 
3. On the desired row, select **Document**  in the OLIS Full Report column

COVID-19 Test and Vaccination Information Display in the Medications Portlet

Healthcare providers document the administration of COVID-19 vaccinations in COVaxON. The Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR) provides a subset of this information in near real-time to the ClinicalViewer.


COVID-19 vaccination information displays as a drug rather than as a professional service (as is the case for flu vaccination information). [COVID-19 test information displays in the Medications portlet only when a pharmacy performs the test and does not include test results.](#) Consult the Lab and Pathology Results portlet for the test results.

To view COVID-19 information:

1. Adjust the timeline as required
2. In the Medications portlet, select **Expand** 
OR
On the Navigation bar, select **Medications** 
3. Select the desired row and scroll down to Detail View

+ Displays the name of the healthcare provider who administered the vaccination or test. If the vaccination or test was administered at a pharmacy, Prescriber and Pharmacist fields may have the same value

Notes

- COVID-19 vaccination information may not be available due to either slow application response or temporary unavailability. Refreshing the ClinicalViewer () may result in successfully retrieving and displaying the information. **Be aware that the absence of vaccine information does not necessarily mean the patient has not been vaccinated.**
- Existing DHDR consent directives and processes remain the same and apply to COVax_{ON} records:
 - If a patient has blocked access to their DHDR records and a COVID-19 vaccination record is available for that patient, the COVax_{ON} record will also be blocked
 - When a patient/substitute decision maker’s consent and signature are obtained and a temporary consent override is performed, all available DHDR and COVax_{ON} information is unblocked

However, at the time of COVID-19 vaccination, if a patient does not consent to share their information, it is not entered into COVax_{ON}. Therefore, a record of the vaccination is not available in COVax_{ON} or DHDR.
