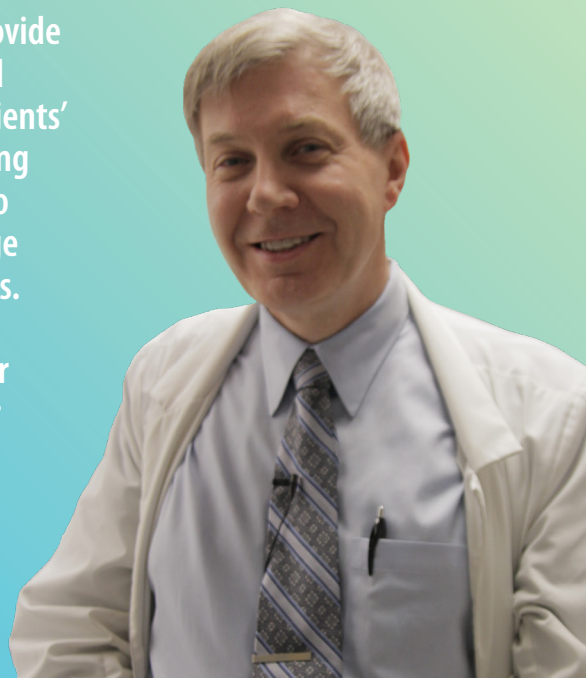

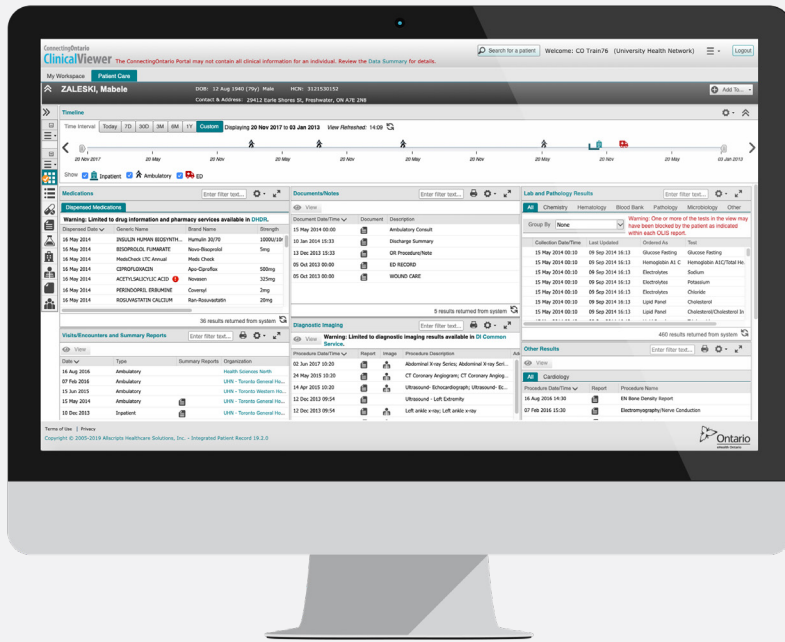

ConnectingOntario provides convenient access to critical patient information. The ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer displays a patient's journey including emergency visits, hospital admissions and home and community care services. New information is being added all the time.

Accessing the ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer

Access patients' health information in a secure and seamless manner using eHealth Ontario's ONE®ID service via:

- ✔ the web, or
- ✔ your organization's electronic health record system.

Single sign-on enables you to log in once and get the right information at the right time, when you need it most.

Health care providers can access additional information not available in their local electronic health record system.

Benefits

Real-time comprehensive patient health records:

- ✔ Enables faster and more informed clinical decision-making
- ✔ Facilitates improved interactions with patients
- ✔ Reduces duplicate testing

Seamless access to providers in the continuum of care includes:
